



USCA COVID-19 Event Guidelines

Event Guidelines

- We will follow state and municipal guidelines in relation to COVID-19.
- We require or strongly encourage (depending on local guidelines) all participants and workers to wear masks.
- All published local guidelines will be on hand for easy reference.
- We will provide COVID-19 prevention supplies to event staff and volunteers—such as hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol, disposable gloves, trash baskets, disposable face masks and cleaners/disinfectants. We still ask that you bring your own when possible.
- We ask that anyone who is at higher risk for severe illness, feeling unwell, or who has been in contact with anyone that is sick in the last two weeks to stay home.
- Drivers are limited to four guests (crew or family) per car. No exceptions.
- Shared coolers are discouraged to decrease the spread of the virus.
- We will clean frequently touched surfaces such as tables, counters, doorknobs, light switches, pens, keyboards, and cones (when used) with disinfectant in regular intervals.
- We will ensure there are plenty of hand washing stations and/or hand sanitizers in and around the facility, particularly high traffic areas.
- Event is closed to spectators.
- Depending on the space available in the paddock, we ask drivers to park 10 – 12' away from other vehicles or as far as paddock space allows.
- Only essential workers are allowed in specialty work areas such as timing and scoring, race control, autocross trailer, OPTIMA stage or office.
- Signs will be placed around the venue to remind people of social distancing and protective health protocols.
- Six feet of space should be kept between individuals for the entirety of the event, except in cases of participants that are part of the same household.
- Anyone who continues to ignore social distancing procedures even after staff input may need to be asked to leave.

Tech

- Only the driver may bring the car to tech. One person only, no crew.
- Mask must be worn while you are in tech.

- Bring your own pen.
- Maintain social distancing when possible.
- Maintain a car length between cars in tech line.
- Decals packs will be rolled up and set out on a table so you can pick up your own.
- Tech inspectors will be wearing masks and gloves.

- Hard surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.

Registration

- Only the driver is permitted to be at registration.
- Mask must be worn while at registration
- If possible, complete all payments before arriving to registration.
- Registration line will be marked to maintain social distancing.
- Bring your own pen.
- Show driver's license and insurance to Registrar, do not hand them over.

- Registration staff will be wearing masks and gloves.
- Hard surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.

Drivers Meeting

- Driver meetings will be held outside and social distancing protocols will be followed however, holding meetings over the PA, FM radio stations, via live stream and/or via email is preferred if possible.
- There will be a Q&A about COVID-19 procedures in the drivers meeting.
- If used, the microphone will not be shared.

Road Course

- Transponders will be disinfected before being issued to drivers.
- Only drivers are allowed on road course grid. No crew.
- Drivers must remain within arm's reach of cars while on grid.
- Grid spots will be spread out more than usual.
- Black flag or segment manager will be wearing a mask when speaking with drivers.

Road Rally

- Driver meetings will be held outside and social distancing protocols will be followed.
- Staff and Media are prohibited from riding with participants during the road rally.
- You will be required to seal your own envelope with your driver's license in front of the registration staff.
- You will be required to open your own envelope in front of the staff at check in then show them your driver's license.

Design and Engineering (D&E)

- Only the driver may bring the car to D&E. One person only, no crew.
- Drivers must remain within arm's reach of their cars while in line.
- Mask must be worn while you are in D&E.
- Maintain social distancing when possible.
- No handing out of informational materials to judges. Non-contact sheets and props are still permitted.
- D&E Judges will be wearing masks.

Autocross and Speed Stop

- Only drivers are allowed on grid. No crew.
- Drivers must remain within arm's reach of cars while on grid.
- Grid spots will be spread out more than usual.
- No time slips will be handed out.
- Segment manager will be wearing a mask when speaking to drivers.

Award Ceremony

- Award ceremony will be held outside and social distancing protocols will be followed.
- No physical contact; refrain from hugging, shaking hands and high-fives.
- Utilize "No Contact" trophy presentation. Trophies will be set on table then wiped down with disinfectant. Trophy winners will pick up their own trophy.
- If used, the microphone will not be shared.
